## Fire Safety Development Module 3

To enable Fire and Rescue Service personnel who require training to become fire safety advisers, managers and engineers as detailed within the National Occupational Standards for Fire Safety.

### DESIGNED FOR

Fire officers who may have responsibility for advising on fire safety design submissions within existing, new or altered premises. Fire officers who may have responsibility for advising on complex fire safety measures.

### ENTRY CRITERIA

Delegates require:

- Adequate experience within a fire safety role
- Attended Modules 1 & 2 or equivalent (Modules A & B)

### AIM

To develop, and enhance, the knowledge and skills of personnel in the subject of Fire Safety

To contribute to the development of fire safety officers in their role as either fire safety adviser, manager or engineer.

The topic areas covered will include:

- Week 1 – Scottish Building Standards - Construction – Procedural Handbook, compartmentation, separation and
- Week 2 – Structural protection, Escape.
- Week 3 – Escape, fire service access, fire service facilities, residential care, hospitals and enclosed shopping centres.

### LEARNING OUTCOMES

After successful completion of the course, the delegates should be able to:

- Define the legislative framework, mechanisms of enforcement and consultation procedures relating to the fire safety elements of current Building Regulations.
- Evaluate, in accordance with approved guidance, fire safety design submissions in connection with consultations between the building standards authority and the fire authority and make recommendations where appropriate.
- Evaluate design submissions which adopt alternative and engineered solutions to fire safety designs including analysis of risk.

### DELIVERY MODE

By interactive lessons, presentations, discussions, practical exercises, individual research and Syndicate work.

### ASSESSMENT & REPORTING

The assessment will comprise of a written assessment of underpinning knowledge for the module. A pass or fail grade is given.

### CERTIFICATION
